

Cook-Off Team Guidelines



General

Entry fees are non-refundable.

Competitor spaces will be pre-assigned in the order of paid registration.

Max booth dimensions 10'x20'.

All team members are required to wear the wristband provided as it acts as your ticket in to the festival.

The Southern Cast Iron Cook-Off is rain or shine.

Contests and Judging

Awards will be presented for first, second, and third place and for a spirit award. You must be present to accept an award.

Each team will be provided a judging time for their dish to be presented to the judges.

Set-Up and Break Down

Booth set-up is Friday, November 1, 2019 from 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. All large items must be moved in at this time.

Each competitor is responsible for the cleanup of their booth.

Any competitor using grease/oil is responsible for providing proper absorbent ground covering in their booth area. Grease must be deposited off site.

Equipment and Supplies

Each competitor will provide all supplies including ingredients, cooking apparatuses, fuel, chairs, trash bags, etc.

Each team will be provided a 10'x10' tent, one 6' table, sign with team name, and one parking spot in designated vendor area (additional public parking will be available) and water access.

Each booth will be required to have a 2A:10BC portable fire extinguisher in view at all times.

Electricity is available for an additional fee.

Upgraded booth space is available for an additional fee.

Ice will be available for purchase onsite.

Cooking

All cooking must be done in cast iron.

Only prep-work such as cutting and marinating is allowed prior to arriving to the cook-off.
